Have each of you fully disclosed to the other all of your respective incomes and expenses, assets, along with a reasonable approximation of the fair market value of such assets, and liabilities, along with a reasonable approximation of their respective amounts? (This is required in order to enter into a Premarital Agreement)
17. Do the two of you wish to keep separate the property currently belonging to each of you and titled in your own name?
18. Do the two of you wish to keep separate all income, rents or profits from your own property?
19. Do the two of you wish to keep separate the appreciation in value of your separate property?
20. Do the two of you wish to keep separate any property purchased from the proceeds of the management or sale of such separate property?
21. Do the two of you wish to keep separate any property coming to either of you during the marriage through gift, bequest, or inheritance?
22. Do the two of you agree that income earned during the marriage from gainful employment of either of you shall be considered marital property, and shall be used to meet household and other expenses?

23. Do the two of you wish to keep your respective liabilities and obligations separate?
24. Do the two of you agree to release any rights or claims which you might otherwise have in the event of the death of the other?
25. Do each of you agree to waive and release any rights or claims which you might otherwise have in or to any property of the other in the event of dissolution of the marriage?
26. Do each of you agree to make no claim for spousal support or maintenance in the event of the dissolution of the marriage?
27. Are each of you 18 years of age or older and of sound mind?
